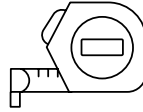

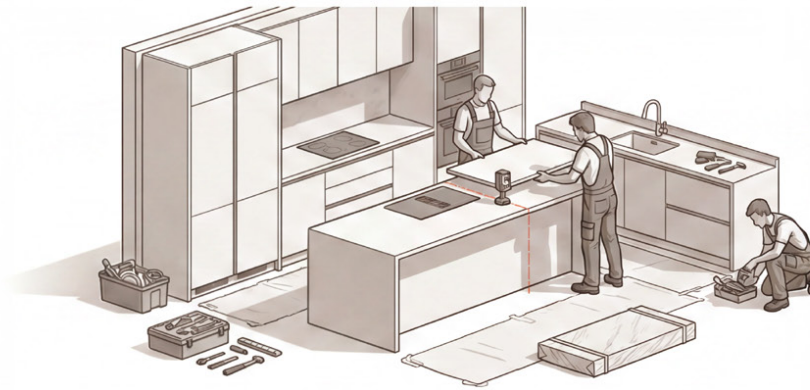

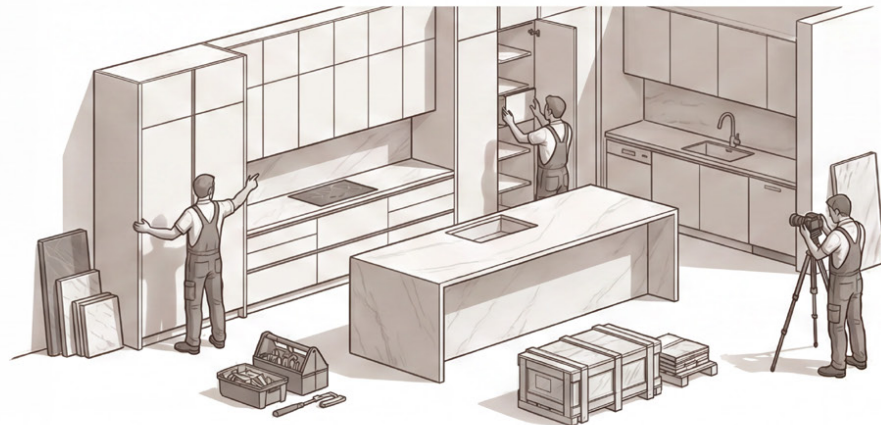

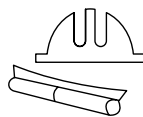
EXAMPLE OF A TYPICAL HALF-DAY INSTALLATION COMPRISING A SINGLE KITCHEN ISLAND

INSTALLATION TIMES

Installation times vary depending on project scale and complexity. Prior to the installation date, our team discusses the project with the client to provide an estimated timeline for completion. On the morning of installation, the client or site contact is notified of the estimated arrival time and expected duration.

Our installation teams typically comprise two skilled installers. Occasionally, a photographer may accompany the team to document the completed installation.

Unlike natural materials such as wood and marble, porcelain is entirely non-porous, creating an exceptionally hygienic, anti-bacterial surface ideal for food preparation. Its compact, non-porous nature prevents bacterial growth, making it the preferred choice for residential kitchens, hotels, restaurants, and commercial hospitality environments.



Porcelain stoneware is NSF certified, meeting the highest standards for safety, quality, and performance in food preparation environments.



STAIN, HEAT & SCRATCH RESISTANCE

Porcelain stoneware delivers exceptional resistance to stains, heat, and scratches. Coffee, red wine, and acidic substances wipe clean effortlessly. Hot pans placed directly from hobs pose no risk. With a Mohs hardness rating of 8, porcelain proves substantially more scratch resistant than most alternative surfaces. We recommend using chopping boards, trivets, and placemats to preserve polished surface finishes.

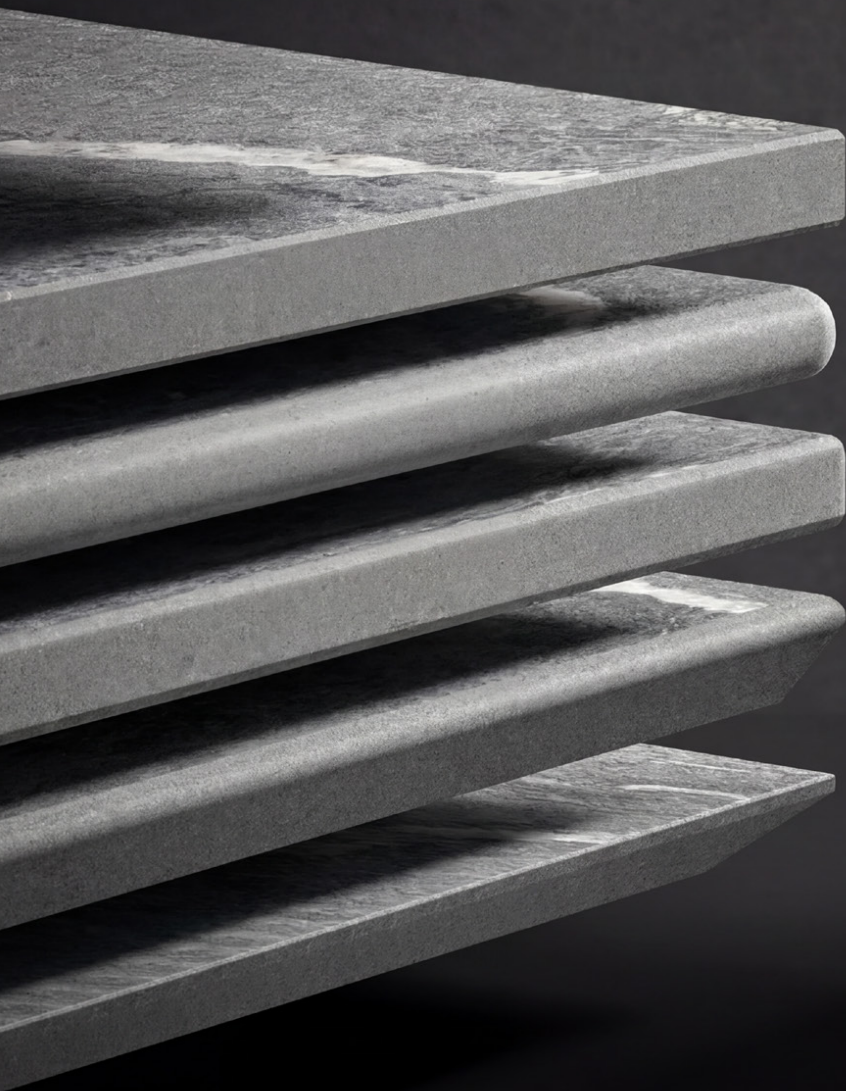

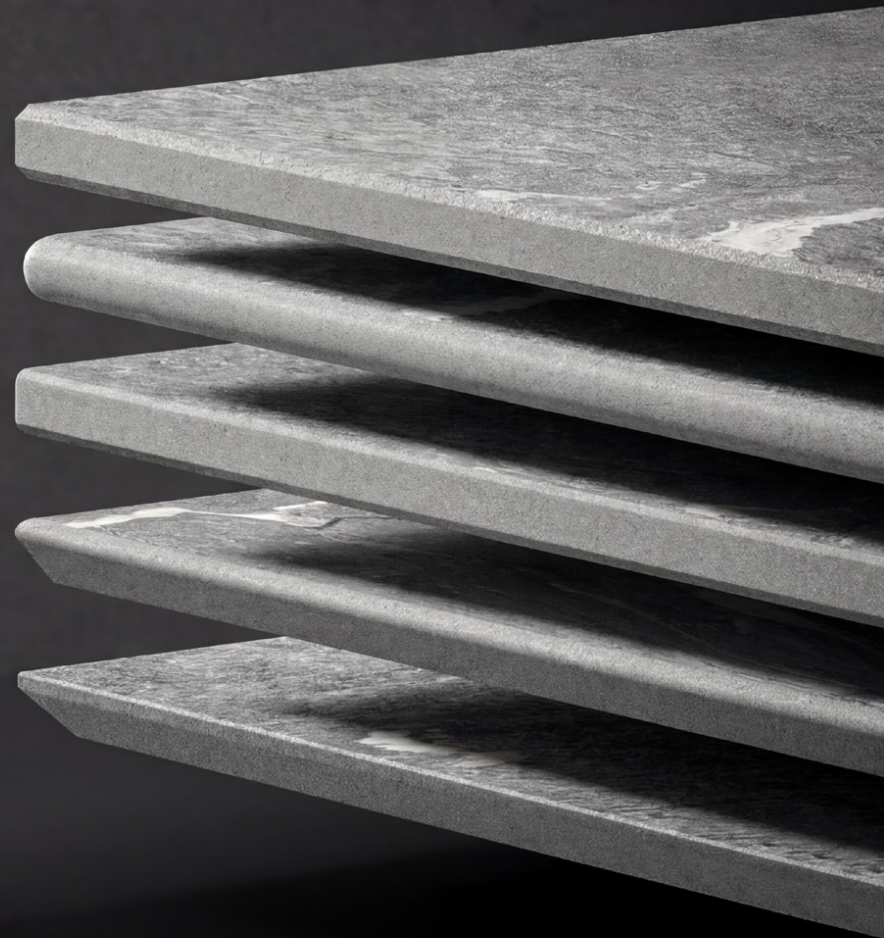
The following table is the Mohs scale of hardness ranging from 1 to 10 used to determine a material's scratch resistance. The Mohs scale uses ten fairly common minerals of known hardness and gives each of them a relative value of 1-10. Each mineral in the scale will scratch those with lesser values and will not scratch those with higher values.

Porcelain stoneware is considered to have a Mohs rating of 8.

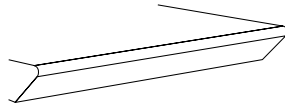
DOUBLE BEVELLED EDGE



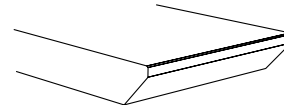
BULLNOSE EDGE



DOUBLE PENCIL EDGE



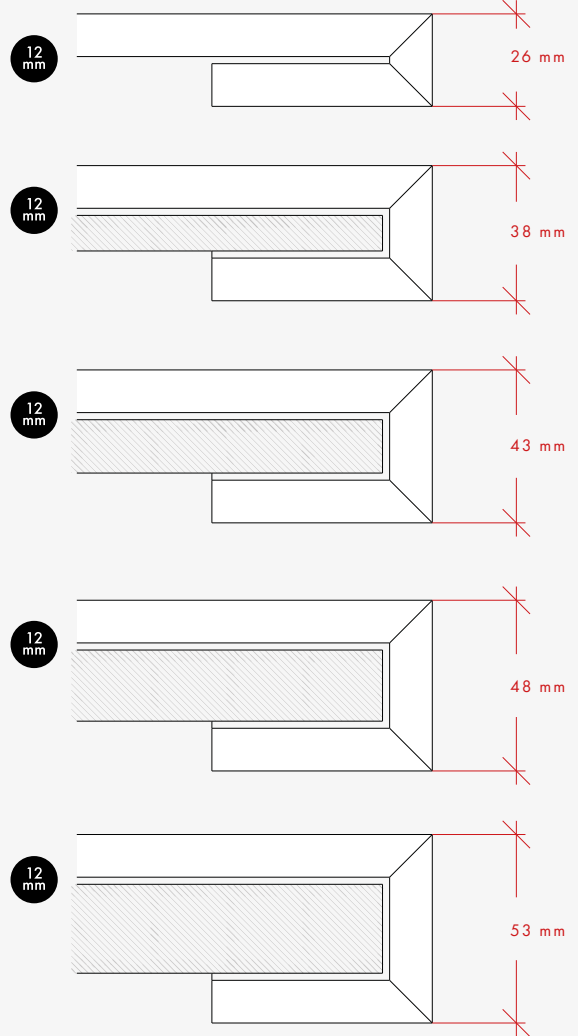
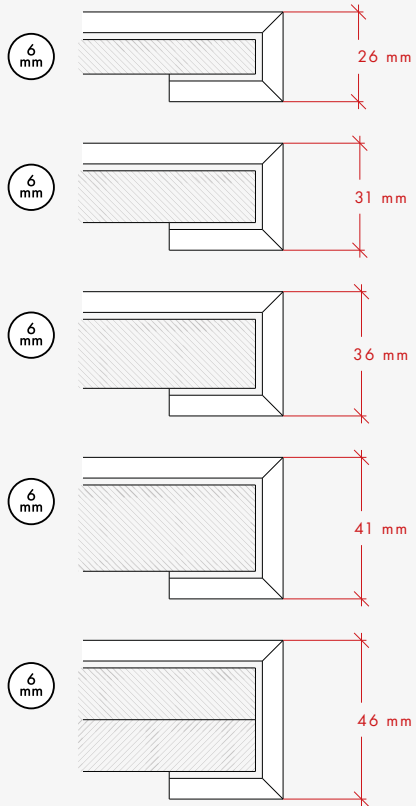
SHARK NOSE EDGE

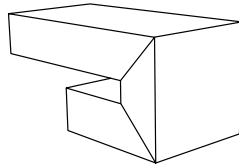


SPECIAL SHARK NOSE EDGE

Cladded countertops and islands can be specified from 26mm to 100mm in thickness, featuring a precisely finished mitred apron return edge profile. Where specified, vein matching ensures continuous material flow across all cladded surfaces for complete visual coherence. Suitable for both residential and commercial kitchen environments, these substantial surfaces combine refined elegance with outstanding performance.



MAINTENANCE

Porcelain stoneware is virtually maintenance free, requiring no sealing or re-sealing. For everyday cleaning, warm water and a soft microfibre cloth proves sufficient. For stubborn stains, use a non-abrasive cleaner or sugar soap. Avoid abrasive sponges, polishing machines, and waxes. For regular kitchen maintenance, we recommend specialist ceramic cleaning products from Fila Solutions and Lithofin.

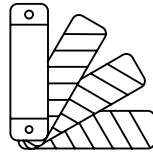
